Optical Mouse User's Guide

1. Optical Mouse

Our optical mouse uses one of the newly developed sensors for the replacement of the traditional ball mouse.

This sensor enables the cursor for smooth and fast tracking even under variety of surfaces.

2. Connect the Mouse

- For PS2 mouse port, please turn off the computer before installation.
- For USB port, you can just remove the PS2 mouse port and direct plug into the computer for usage.

3. Troubleshooting

The mouse does not function after plug in or is not detected

- Make sure you have connected the mouse properly. The mouse cable goes into the computer's USB port or PS2 port.
- For PC's, make sure the PS2 mouse port has the proper configuration, Please refer your computer user's guide for port configuration.
- Please check the IRQ/address setting of this device; you may need to adjust the setting.
- You may need to unplug the connection and reconnect again.

4. The Screen Cursor does not track well

Try to avoid your tabletop surface in red color or is highly reflective like a mirror, your tabletop surface may be interfering the optical sensor or you can place your mouse on a mouse pad.

Troubleshooting–Cursor

If the Screen Cursor does not track well...

- Try to avoid using highly reflective or red color tabletops.
- Your tabletop surface may interfere with the optical sensor.
- You can place your mouse on a mouse pad to avoid this problem.

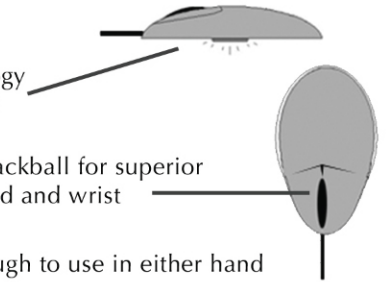

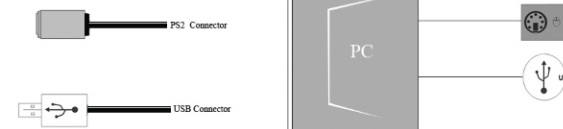
