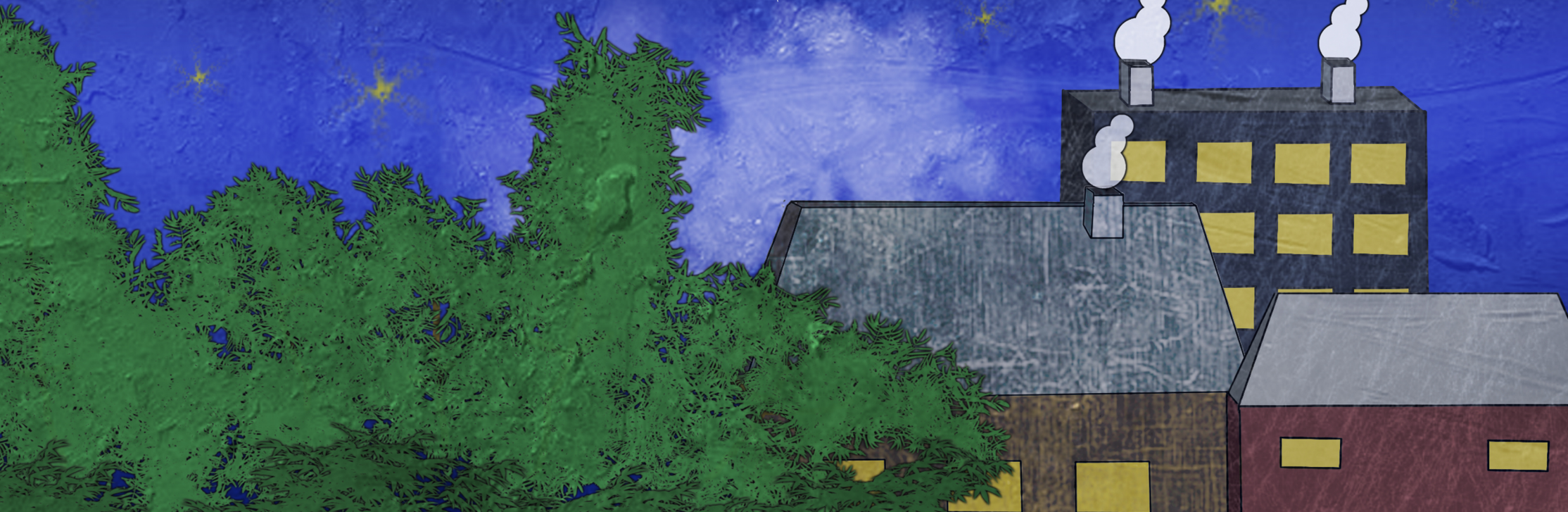




# Gracie And Her Night Night Adventure

So, they played hide and seek in the woods.



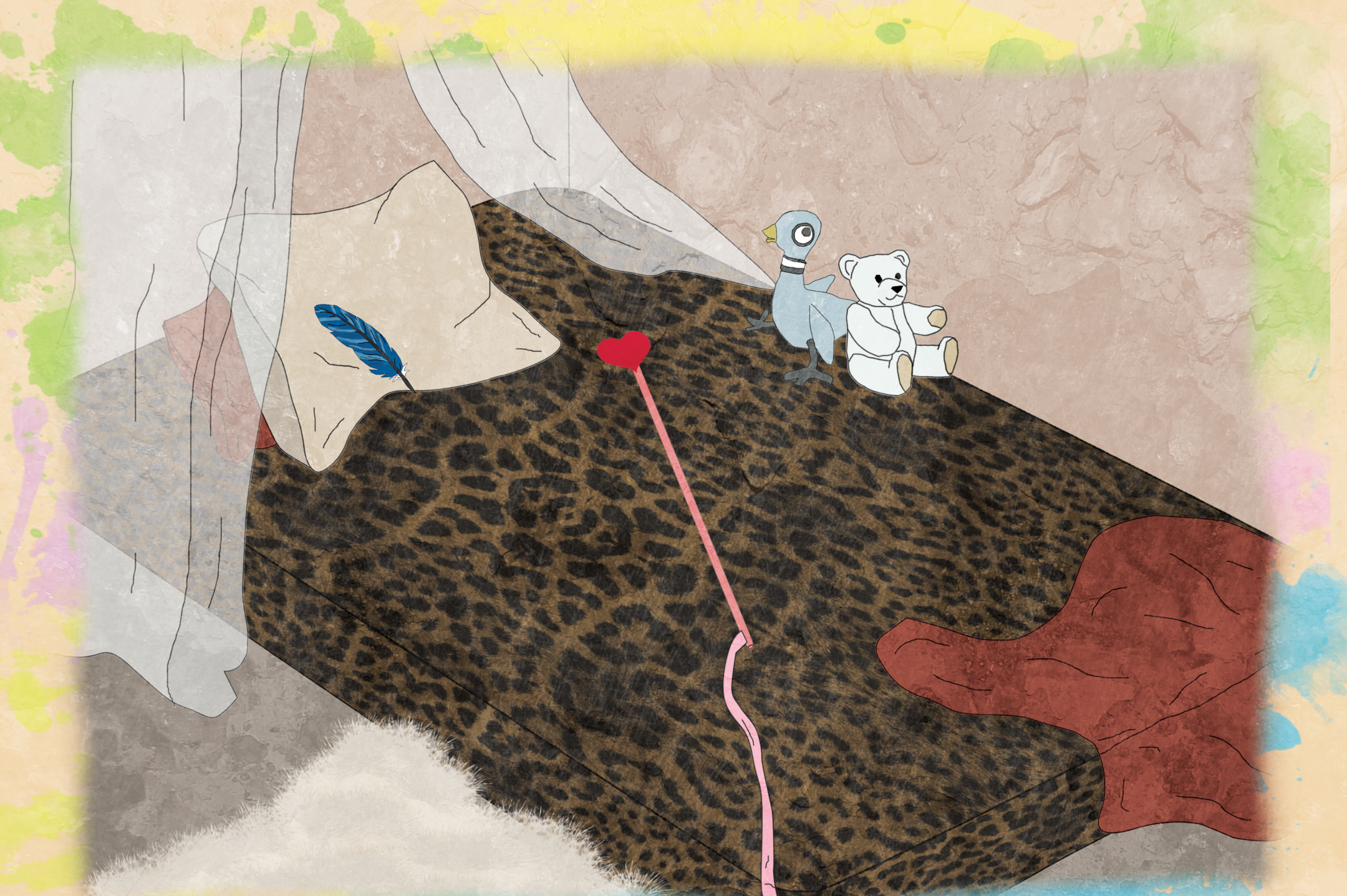


When it was Gracie's turn to hide, she found a nice hiding place with soft grass and pretty flowers. Her eyes were very heavy and she soon fell fast asleep.
